Vendor Vending Rules & Regulations

Food vendors agree to the following terms and conditions for participation in the following area:

Licensing

1. Food vendors will obtain and display an appropriate license to conduct a temporary food service operation issued by the Montgomery County Combined Health District and abide by all the temporary food operations guidelines. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of this agreement. If necessary, send a copy of the temporary food vendor license to the Food Vendor Chairperson by June 26, 2006, with the final required items.

Certificate of Insurance

1. **Food vendors will name both the United Irish of Dayton, Inc. and Five Rivers Metro Parks** as additional issued on the vendor's liability insurance policy for the Dayton Celtic Festival, July 28 through July 30, 2006. The food vendor must provide a certificate of insurance in the amount of no less than 1 million dollars to the Food Vendor Chairperson no later than June 26, 2006, which documents this coverage. Food vendors will further indemnify and hold harmless from any and all loss, claims, demands, liability and actions in conjunction with this event and this agreement. Failure to do so will result in the cancellation of this agreement.

Payment Schedule

1. Food vendors will pay the United Irish of Dayton, Inc. the amount of **\$600** to rent a 20-feet wide by 10-feet deep space for the three day event. For each additional space of 10-feet by 10-feet the food vendor will incur an additional charge of \$250. All payments due and payable are to be made in the following manner:
 - a) Unrefundable deposit of \$100 per 20-feet by 10-feet space due upon signing the agreement.
 - b) Amount remaining \$500 per 20-feet by 10-feet space due no later than June 26, 2006.
 - c) Additional charges for additional 10-feet by 10-feet space due no later than June 26, 2006.
 - d) All payments are to be made payable to, "United Irish of Dayton, Inc."**
 - e) The time of payments listed above are of the essence.
 - f) A picture of your booth is required with your deposit, if you are new to this event.

Rental of Festival Space

1. Food vendors will occupy the space, and only that space designated by the Dayton Celtic Festival.
2. Any food vendor using a tent as part of their display will be responsible for stabilizing said tent. No stakes will be permitted on the festival site.
3. The general appearance of each food vending unit, equipment and employees will be factor in the vendor's acceptance at future festivals. Food vendors are expected to maintain high standards of cleanliness among their employees.
4. The food vendor's space must be left clean with all trash placed in receptacles provided by the Dayton Celtic Festival and the City of Dayton, Division of Waste Collection. Any trash that will not fit into the receptacles must be taken away and disposed of at the food vendor's expense. Absolutely no ice, charcoal, or grease may be left on the festival grounds or in waste collection receptacles. Those items must be placed in the proper containers provided. All gray water must be disposed of down a sink, not in the sewer system.

Storage Area

1. Food vendors will not be allowed to have storage units within their space.
2. Vendors with an extra storage trailer will be allowed to park their storage trailer off the main festival site. This must be coordinated with the food vendor chairperson prior to June 26, 2006.

Food Requirements

1. Each food vendor will be provided with access to water.
2. **NOTE:** Water will not be at each booth. The food vendor will need a water portable hose to get access to the water supply.
3. **NOTE:** The water provided is not recommended for drinking, it will be coming from an irrigation system.
4. Ice will be accessible to all food vendors for an additional charge. This information will be provided to you upon approval of you agreement.

Time Frames

1. The food vendor will operate in that space from 5:00-11:00 p.m. on Friday, July 28; from 12:00-11:00 p.m. Saturday, July 29; and 11:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m. Sunday, July 30, 2006.
2. Approved food vendors will be notified regarding set up arrival times and space allotment to ensure that all food vendors will be operational by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, July 28, 2006.
3. Food vendors will remove all equipment, supplies and vehicles from the Dayton Celtic Festival area by 5:00 p.m., Friday, July 28, by 12:00 p.m., on Saturday, July 29, and by 10:00 a.m., on Sunday, July 30, 2006.
4. The Dayton Celtic Festival times are expected to be:
 - a) Friday, July 28, 2006 from 5:00 p.m. through 11:00 p.m.
 - b) Saturday, July 29, 2006 from 12:00 p.m. through 11:00 p.m.
 - c) Sunday, July 30, 2006 from 11:00 a.m. through 6:00 p.m.
5. All vendor equipment will remain on the festival site until Sunday, July 30, 2006 when released by food vendor chairperson.
6. Each vendor will be given a one-half hour time period to place their items/equipment at their location. After which time all vehicles must be removed from the festival grounds. Parking off the festival site will be the responsibility of the food vendor. Reserved parking in an adjacent parking lot will be available for vendors and workers.

Additional Sales Information

1. The food vendor will sell **only** the products listed on the Vendor Specification Sheet and must sell the items for the price listed on the Vendor Specification Sheet. **No beverage sales will be permitted by any food vendor.** Only the Dayton Celtic Festival may sell these items.
2. You may not use any public address systems or other sound amplification system as part of their vending operation.
3. No food vendor will be allowed to use a mobile vending unit.

Safety Issues

1. All food vendors using flammable liquid or solids must provide suitable fire protective equipment - fire extinguishers. If a food vendor cannot present a fire extinguisher to safety officials - Dayton Fire Department staff - the food vendor is required to acquire such equipment.
2. According to the Ohio State Fire Marshal's Code, you may not have open flames such as those from gas or propane, under tent cover.

Electrical Usage

1. Wiring to units is to be provided by vendors. They are to provide protective devices of the proper size for their units.
2. Food vendors will have access to electricity as provided by Five Rivers Metro Parks.

General Information

1. Five Rivers Metro Parks prohibits camping and/or sleeping on festival grounds.
2. No political promotions, fund-raising, raffles or games of chance are permitted on festival grounds.
3. You may not have any pets, other than guide/assistance dogs, on the festival grounds.

Closing

1. Violations of these rules or conduct contrary to the best interests of the Dayton Celtic Festival will not be permitted. Violators will be asked to remove their units and to leave the property and no fees will be refunded in such cases.
